NORA (V.O)

NORA gets off the taxi first. While JOSHUA stays in the car.

JOSHUA

Love -- can't walk you home this time. I need to pick up some milk first. Let's see... it's 10:12 already, you wanna come to my place at 11?

NORA

Okay. Yeah.

NORA starts walking but quickly turns around.

NORA

Wait. I don't know your apartment number yet.

JOSHUA

It's 1505. See ya!

NORA watches the taxi driving away, then quickly walks into the building.

INT. BACHELOR'S PAD - NIGHT

JOSHUA talks to his childhood best friend TED on the phone, while keeps glancing at his watch.

TED

JOSHUA

(pause shortly)

NORA knocks on JOSHUA's door.

JOSHUA

JOSHUA walks quietly towards the door.

JOSHUA

(open the door)

Hey.

NORA

Hey. Bad timing?

JOSHUA

All good. I was just talking to my mom on the phone.

NORA

How is she?

JOSHUA

Who? Oh, my mom. Yeah, she's fine. Said she misses me. I honestly wish I could see her more often. You know, she always worries about me. But I just want her to be happy.

NORA

She must feel so lucky having a son like you.

JOSHUA falls silent. He sits down on a couch and checks NORA out from a distance.

JOSHUA (V.O.)

NORA (V.O.)

if I act as if I am inexperienced, maybe he will have more compassion for me.

JOSHUA (V.O.)

The anxiety has never been higher -- I need to put on a good show.

NORA sits down next to JOSHUA. The silence lasts for quite a while.

NORA

(chuckle)

Your heart is beating fast.

JOSHUA

(look into NORA's eyes)
So are you.

JOSHUA (V.O.) (CONT'D)

There have been other guys who made her feel more than I am able to.

NORA (V.O.)

I do not wish to proceed unless I know I mean more than a temporary companion to him.

JOSHUA embraces and kisses NORA.

JOSHUA (V.O.)

I hope she will not think this gesture has any romantic implications.

NORA

But Josh, I don't really want things to happen too fast. We should go the classy way: like going out for coffee or something!

JOSHUA

Yes. We should.

NORA

What do you think of me now?

JOSHUA

Let's just say I really really care about you.

JOSHUA (V.O) (CONT'D)

NORA raises her head and, with curiosity, looks into JOSHUA's eyes. JOSHUA tries to interpret the look and reciprocate it back to NORA.

NORA (V.O)

He is not the one to trust.

JOSHUA (V.O)

NORA (V.O)

Don't lose hope. Keep it slow. If things move slowly there will be a second time.

MARIA stands up. JOSHUA is not expecting her leaving so soon.

NORA (CONT'D)

Listen, I'd better go tonight. I need to get up early tomorrow.

JOSHUA

Before you go, I should give you another kiss.

JOSHUA embraces and kisses NORA, for a longer time.

NORA

(take a step back)

I should really go... but you should text me -- I am free tomorrow night! You will be down to catch up again, right?

JOSHUA

EXT. WOODS - NIGHT [FLASHBACK]

Darkness is all around. Wind is howling. NORA runs as fast as she can to find the exit, but finally has to stop and catch a breath. NORA pants heavily.

NORA

Without a single response, NORA sits down by a tree and starts to cry. At this moment, NORA's phone buzzes. NORA reads the texts.

MAYBE: JOSHUA (V.O.)

NORA stops crying and lets out a stifled laugh. Just when NORA is about to text back, she receives more and more texts from MAYBE: JOSHUA.

NORA (V.O.)

MAYBE: JOSHUA (V.O.)

NORA (V.O.)

MAYBE: JOSHUA (V.O.)

NORA

NORA

JOSHUA

NORA

(show disappointment)
In that case... good luck with that.

getting?

JOSHUA

(smile)
